

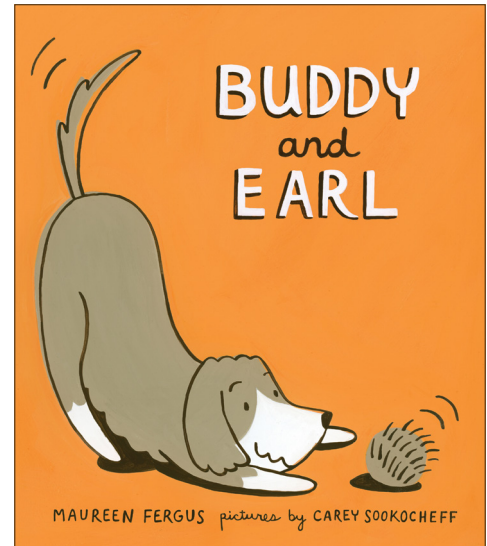


Yo-ho-ho! Make a Pirate Hat with **BUDDY** and **EARL**

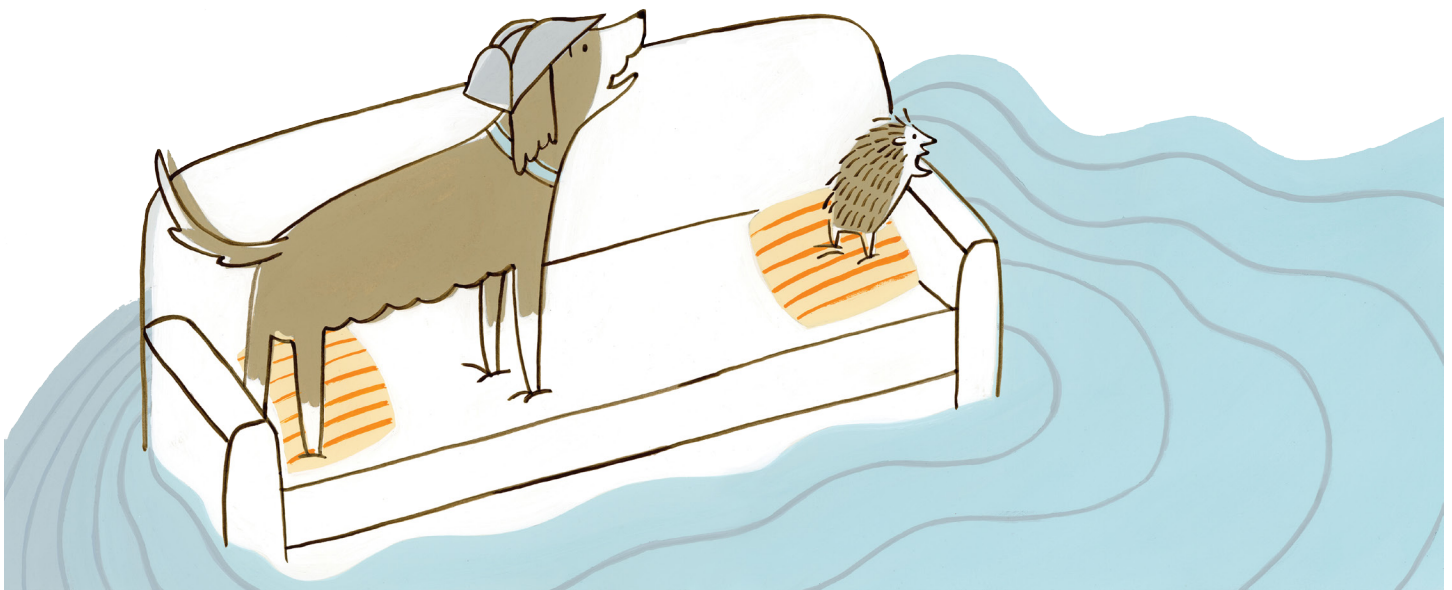
Inspired by *Buddy and Earl* and *Buddy and Earl Go Exploring*,

All hands on deck! Find an old newspaper — or another large sheet of paper — and join Buddy and Earl on a fun adventure!

1. Place your piece of paper in front of you, with the long edges running along the top and bottom.
2. Fold your paper in half vertically and crease.
3. Next, fold your paper in half horizontally and crease.
4. Unfold the horizontal crease you just made.
5. Turn your piece of paper so that the folded edge is running along the top.
6. Fold the top corners of the paper down diagonally to meet the center line and crease.
7. Fold one of the bottom flaps up.
8. Turn your piece of paper over and fold the other bottom flap up.
9. Pull the sides apart and give your new hat a try.
10. Climb aboard — it's time to hit the high seas!
