Dear Polor Bears

> Polar bears, on the other hand, are truly Arctic animals and are a single species, *Ursus maritimus.* They range all over the Arctic and are found in the United States (in Alaska), Canada, Greenland, Norway (in Svalbard) and Russia. The North Pole (the very tippy top of the world) is 12,430 miles (20,004 kilometers) from the South Pole. Polar bears never range farther south than James Bay in Canada, but from there they **would still have to travel more than 10,000 miles (16,093 kilometers) to get to the penguin party in Antarctica.**
