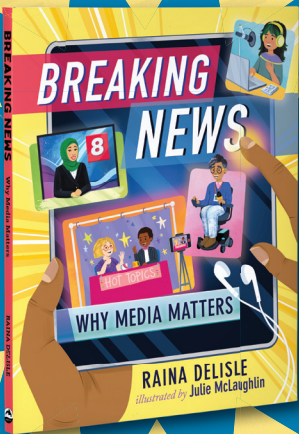


WHO PUTS TOGETHER THE NEWS?

plan, oversee, review and revise the work of reporters.



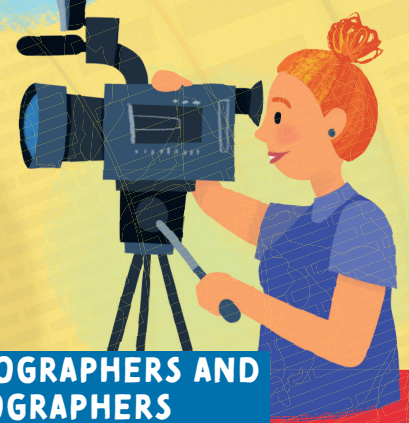
FACT-CHECKERS

HOSTS

PRODUCERS

work behind the scenes to get TV, radio and podcast shows on the air.
